- Use as many of the building blocks as you can and others you know
- You need to use a number of joiners eg. engari, nā te mea, heoi anō etc
- Make sure your tuhinga is accurate
- Make sure your tuhinga is easy to read and is understandable
- Pay close attention to detail
- Aim for 250-300 words
